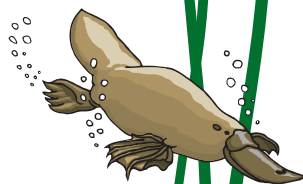

Conditions of Entry

Please read carefully as these conditions are non-negotiable.

1. Entry Fees (which have remained unchanged 8 years) must be included with the entry form and received by **25th May, 2011**. Paintings are \$20 per entry. Payment by cheque or money order to Maleny Art Awards and Exhibition. Any entry that is not being personally collected after the Exhibition will attract a **\$10** repacking charge i.e. per artist not per painting.
Entry fees are not refundable under any circumstances.
2. Each Competitor is limited to a total of TWO (2) ENTRIES in the Exhibition (These may be in the same section) NOTE: two (2) MINIATURES are classified as one (1) entry (\$20); thus four (4) miniatures (\$40) are acceptable.
3. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE FOR SALE and a commission of 25% will be charged on all sales.
4. If there are fewer than 10 entries in any section; a prize will only be awarded at the discretion of the judge. A prize may not be awarded under specific categories, unless entries are judged to have reached an appropriate standard.
5. Each entry MUST BE SUITABLY FRAMED **with a cord or wire securely attached for hanging.** Works on stretchers are acceptable.
6. Each entry MUST be an ORIGINAL WORK of the artist and painted within the last twelve months. **NO COPIES, ETCHINGS OR PRINTS will be accepted.** An entry must not have been a prize winner at any Art Exhibition.
7. Size of Paintings—See page 2 of the entry form for sizes.
8. Diptych and Triptychs will not be accepted unless fully joined as one entry within the size criteria. All works complying with the rules will be judged and the decision of the judges will be final and binding. All accepted works will be displayed, if possible, but the Committee reserves the right, with no explanation, not to hang an entry if it is deemed unsuitable, or should space be limited.
The Committee also reserves the right to reclassify an entry.

9. Each painting must be **CLEARLY LABELLED** on the back, With the artist's name, address, phone number, title of painting, medium or media used, section and price.
10. The Committee reserves the right to permit, without fee, the photographing or filming of any exhibit for use in newspapers or television to promote the Exhibition only. Any further reproduction of any work must be in consultation with the artist.
11. APEX SPECIAL AWARD - The winning artist must give Reproduction rights to Maleny Apex for Promotional Purposes on the cover of their Business Directory. As a condition of sale, the purchaser of the painting must also give these rights.
12. **Should any dispute arise for which no specific rule is laid down, then the decision of the Committee is final.**
13. **DELIVERY AND COLLECTION**: A receipt will be issued for paintings personally delivered and **must** be presented at the time of collection. If art works are to be collected by someone other than the artist, that person, must be in possession of the receipt **and** a written authority, otherwise the work will not be released. Any entry not collected on the 13th June 2011 will become the property of the Committee of the Maleny Art Awards and Exhibition and will be offered for sale. Monies thus received will go to the Committee's funds. Painting may only be accepted by delivered on Sunday **5th June** or by Australia Post by Friday **3rd June**.
14. The artist acknowledges that the committee accepts no liability for any loss of or damage to any exhibit whilst in transit or in its control. The committee will exercise reasonable care with the exhibits. Entries will only be included for judging if they are to be collected at **4.00pm 13 June 2011** **or** accompanied by the return postage plus **\$10** packing fee. Postage and insurance costs must be prepaid and arranged by the artist.

Our Judge: Kevin Grealy



Kevin GREALY Cert.T. (KGTC), B.Ed (Fine Arts) University of Calgary, Ontario.

Kevin comes with a wealth of experience in the Arts field.

He was born in Brisbane and attended Gregory Terrace Christian Brothers College. He became an Art teacher studying at Kelvin Grove Teachers College. He taught Art at several Queensland High Schools and then became a lecturer at the Queensland University of Technology.

Although primarily a distinguished ceramist, he has worked and taught in the art field for many years. His practice, knowledge and understanding of the principles of good composition have caused him to be invited to judge art competitions in Cairns, Mackay and other provincial cities. For several years, with well known art critic John Massey, he was asked to judge the Fine Arts section of the Brisbane Exhibition Art Show.

His studies, exhibitions and workshops have taken him across the world. He has a passion for Chinese Art and in Sanbao, Jingdezhen City he was artist in residence for nine weeks. He has conducted workshops both in China and Australia and continues to do this.

His work is in the collections of the National Gallery of Australia, the Powerhouse Museum, the Queensland Art Gallery, the Brisbane City Hall Civic Collection, the Redcliffe City Council, several Colleges, corporations and private collections. He is represented in at least four major collections in China.

He has been curator of exhibitions in Australia.

He has had major commissions for ceramic murals, gifts and smaller ceramic devices. He is a frequent writer for international ceramics journals. In 1991 he won the Suncorp Literacy Award. He has been commissioned to write a book on the history and technology of dragon kilns. He has worked as a ceramics consultant in Australia, Vietnam and Taiwan. There is much more to this man whose creativity and skill within his own work is shared with art students and lovers of art from Australia to Taiwan, Vietnam, Spain, China and Canada.

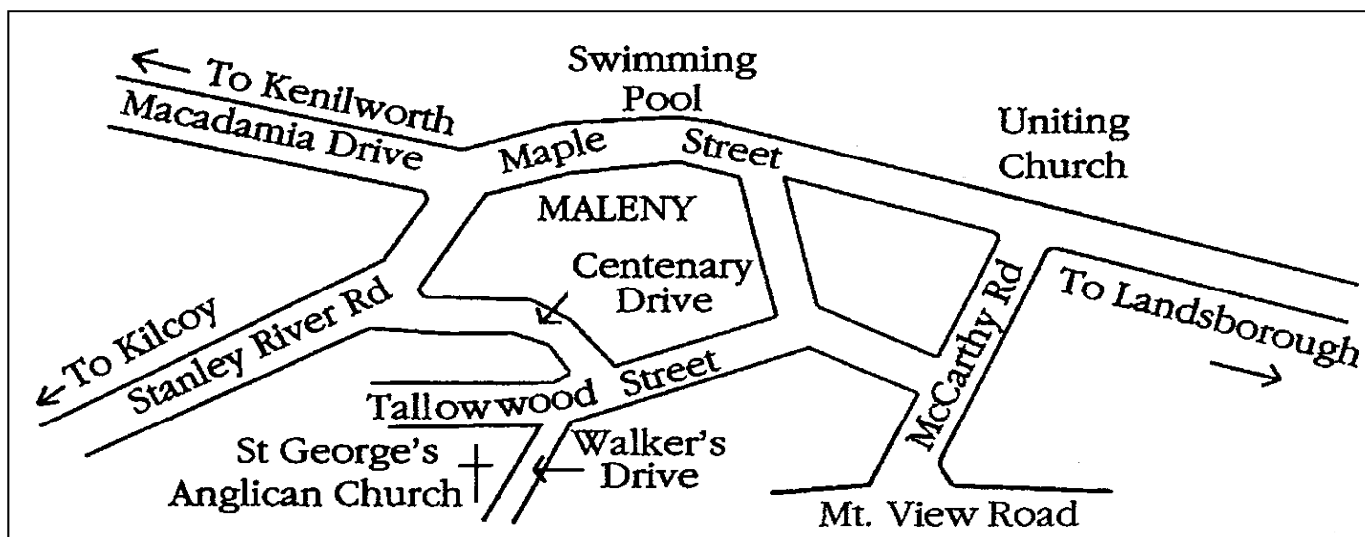
